Join Us

At present, KAS meetings are held at 7:00 on the third Monday night of the month, September through May. The meetings are held upstairs in the Homewood Suites, located between Hwy 59 and Loop 494, just to the north of Kingwood Drive.

It is not required to live in Kingwood to join. Anyone is welcome to be a member, no matter where he or she lives. The club simply meets in Kingwood.

Membership is not limited to professionals and is open to anyone interested in art. We have adult students, school students, non-professionals, etc. Feel free to join if you simply like art and want to be a booster. Our shows have divisions for every level of art experience and proficiency.

Meeting Agenda

The meeting leads with a short business meeting and follows with demonstration by a guest artist or an artist who is a member of the club. The demonstrations are in oil, watercolor, collage, clay, and so forth. The meeting in December is usually potluck, and the one in April is a tasting party. At those meetings we also award our scholarships to Kingwood College Students.

Other KAS events include on-site drawing excursions, participation in charity art auctions, and many other art functions. Information on shows, contests and events are also provided throughout the year.

Benefits of the Club

ART SHOWS

The society sponsors two shows each year - one in the fall and one in the spring. All who pay KAS dues will receive an entry blank in the newsletter. Membership is required to participate in the shows. Forms may also be downloaded off the Web site:

KAS members pay \$6 per entry for up to 10 works. Students only pay \$2 per entry. Consult the membership directory for specific instructions and rules.

LSAG MEMBERSHIP

The letters stand for Lone Star Art Guild. A portion of your KAS dues goes for a membership in LSAG. Any work of art that you enter in a KAS show that wins any ribbon in a show sponsored by a LASG member club (including Kingwood) is eligible to compete in the annual LSAG competition held in May. GALLERY WEB SITE EXPOSURE

Included in the General Membership dues, KAS members will be listed on the KAS Web site with a link to the artist's personal Web site. For an additional Web Gallery fee, KAS will host a gallery of work for the artist that includes a bio (250 words or less) with contact information and up to 9 photos. The photos may be rotated twice a year (January & August). Please see the Web site for more details.
