Abenaki Knitting Basket

ALL LEVELS

Size: 9" Diameter x 10" H

For all you knitters! Here is a basket that you can keep your knitting and your knitting needles. The "Abenaki" refers to a Native American Indian Tribe from the northeastern United States. This basket is a prototype of an old ash basket that would hold yarn, keep it straight and knot-free. You will decide what type of handle you will want—shaker tape or you want to braid your own. I used spaced dyed reed for the overlays but you can choose the color.

INTERMEDIATE

Size: 6" diameter x 6 1/2" High

The twill pattern on this basket is striking due to the contrast of the dyed black ash stakes and natural black ash. The basket is begun on a mold, then removed and hand-shaped. The twill is a 1/1/2/2 with a reversal every 13 rows. It is finished with a dyed half round rim lashed with waxed linen.
