

Melvin Miller (1937-2007) reflects on Elsworth & Kathryn “As I remember this subject, there was a bit of a comparison between these 2 skipjacks. The Elsworth was one of the newer skipjacks. I saw the 'Living Classroom' doing some work on this tight little ship at their pier at the foot of Central Avenue in Baltimore City. She was tight as a drum, no bilge water, no leaking, etc. The Elsworth was one of the smaller skipjacks, probably less than 40 feet long and about 15 foot of beam. To compare this with the Kathryn, she may have been around 60 feet in length. The Kathryn was one of the oldest skipjacks.”
