About the artist:

Rita Kirkman has been using pastel since she was 11 years old. She received her BFA in 1988, and has improved through workshops with renowned pastelists including Richard McKinley, Desmond O'Hagan, and Maggie Price. Since 2003 Kirkman has consistently won major national and international awards. Her work has been featured in the Pastel Journal and the Pratique des Arts Spécial Pastel.
